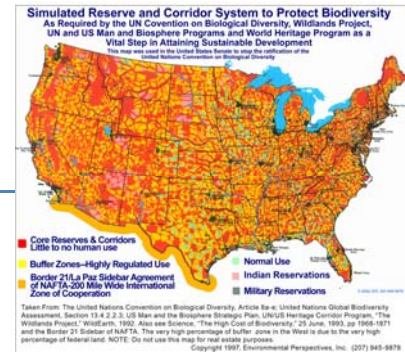


Stopping Sustainable Development - Agenda 21



Guidelines for making a presentation to public officials:

- Attend local town council meetings.
- Get to know your public officials.
- Download the pamphlets (www.didyouknowonline.com/agenda21) to share with officials.
- Prepare your materials, and then ask officials to look at them so you can review at the next meeting.
- When possible, present the brief 14-minute video. (www.didyouknowonline.com/agenda21)
- Collaborate on ways to protect private property rights, eliminate government and NGO influence and stop grant money.

Questions to ask at planning meetings:

- If we get into this program and decide it is not for us, how can we get out of it?
- Who enforces the regulations that accompany these programs? How are they enforced?
- What is meant by "social justice," and "environmental justice"?
- Challenge surveys; and claims "we are losing open space" or are "overpopulated."
- How can we get the entire community represented and not just a handful of residents?
- What are conservation easements? Are they in perpetuity? Who holds the development rights?
- Who pays the taxes if land is confiscated through eminent domain or for open spaces?
- Communities all over the country are pulling out of ICLEI and sustainable development plans because they are discovering the grant money often includes restrictions on their property rights. How can we explore methods of going green without federal money and outside planners?
